

2026 Cullom Junior Fair - Changes, Hints, and Important Info

1. ****Entry deadlines have been moved up one week!!*** Mailed entry postmark date is Monday, July 20. Online entries close at midnight Sunday, July 26th
2. Please be sure to click on the blue **"SUBMIT"** button at the bottom of the last page of on-line entry. Your entries are not entered until this is done.
3. ***On-line entries are very much preferred.*** Please visit our website www.cullomjuniorfair.com or our Facebook page for on-line entry links and fair updates. Entry fees for entries made on-line may be mailed or brought to the fair. If not mailed by Saturday, Aug 1st, please bring to the fair.
4. Please carefully check online entries for duplicates. Once done entering, please click "Review Entries" to double check them.
5. When mailing entry fees for multiple exhibitors with one check, please identify the amount remitted by each exhibitor. Hint: It is very helpful to include a print out/receipt of the online entries with the mailing. (This has been useful in helping us to catch errors in the past)
6. Health papers must be PRINTED and brought to the fair. Please do not ask the fair office to print them!
7. Rabbit Exhibitors: Plan to enter the new Rabbit Costume Class. Rabbit and exhibitor are to be in costume. Check out the great premiums offered compliments of the Riebe Family!
8. Rabbits have added Holland Lop breed and dropped Dutch
9. When making on-line entries, the categories of Junior, 4-H, and Open are not relevant. Pick any one you wish and the entries will feed into the fair just fine!
10. Livestock entry fees are now an "all-in-one", with no additional pen/stall fees.
11. You must type www. in front of Cullom Junior Fair when looking to go to the website.
12. Adult and Junior domestic arts has added a rock painting category.
13. Ag Products has added green beans, wax beans, and tallest corn plant.
14. Floriculture has added tallest sunflower and largest sunflower head classes.
15. All domestic arts, floriculture or ag products entries may be delivered to the Cullom Community Building EITHER Thursday night from 5:30-7 pm OR Friday morning from 8:30-11am.
